

USDA Processing Bottlenecks

USDA Certification: Complicated, lengthy, and expensive processes keep small-scale producers at a disadvantage.

Regulations: Restrictive laws favor large corporations and make it difficult for independent ranchers to compete.

Monopolies: A handful of companies control the vast majority of meat processing, leading to reduced competition.

CAFOs: Concentrated animal feeding operations dominate the industry, leaving small-scale, sustainable farms with fewer opportunities.



KYC: Know Your Cow

Buy Shares: Invest directly in local cattle.

Support Ranching Practices: Choose the methods you believe in.

Health Solutions: Healthier cattle lead to healthier food.

Transparent Labeling: Know exactly what's in your food.

Save Our Farms: Prevent the loss of local farms.

The PRIME Act H.R. 2814
