YFS Agroecology Badge: Level 1 Checklist

- Take a nature walk around the farm, paying attention to water, earth, plants, & animals.
 Bring along a magnifying glass, paper, & colored pencils to draw what you find.
- 2) Which plants & animals that you saw on your walk are part of the farm, & which ones are part of nature?
- 3) What is ecology? Know how nature & the farm work together & help each other.
- 4) How does water move in rivers & ponds? Experiment with swirling water in jars.
- What is irrigation? Shape & change water flow around rivers or ponds to improve irrigation.
- Draw your dream farm, using lots of details & color. Make sure to include wildlife in your picture. Present your design to your classmates.

- Know what tools we use in the garden & how to use them correctly.

- Know about companion planting: tomatoes & basil, Native American Three Sisters.
- 5) What is composting, & how does it make the soil healthy?
